□ Admission Criteria

o Common criteria

- UNIST considers various factors comprehensively including academic ability, study plan, vision and potential based on all the submitted documents such as personal statements, transcripts, English test report, etc.
- Evaluation will be conducted by two or more evaluators.

o Document Screening

- After the document screening, all the applicants are decided as "Accepted", "Interviewed", or "Rejected".
- The only applicants who are decided as "Interviewed" will take an interview.

o Interview

- Online Interview will be only directed to the applicants selected as interviewees and If necessary, we will conduct face to face interview.
- Interview is a qualitative evaluation and It will be focused on applicant's suitability, vision, etc.
- After the interview, Interviewees are decided as "Accepted", "Candidate" or "Rejected".

o Decision of Successful candidates

- All accepted applicants from document screening and interview will be decided as successful candidates.
- We can nominate candidates based on the results of interview.

o Registration

- All successful candidates have to transfer the deposit by deadline.
- If successful candidates will not transfer the deposit, it will be considered as abandonment of registration.
- Additional registration may be conducted among nominated candidates

according to the registration result for Successful candidates.

Important notice for all the applicants

- o If any of the submitted materials contains falsified information, admissions may be cancelled.
- o All admitted students should submit apostille(or legalization) high school diploma and transcripts by deadline. If not, the enrollment will be cancelled.
- o All the submitted documents shall not be returned to the applicants.
- o Even if the admitted students give up enrollment in UNIST, the deposit shall not be returned.
- o Applicants should take full responsibilities for any mistakes or omissions on the application.
- o All the documents should be submitted in English. Any document in another language should be accompanied by a notarized English translation.
